

# IDX / RETS FEED

## How to get an IDX or RETS feed.

1. After talking with your website provider, find out if they need an IDX feed or a RETS feed.
2. The agent or the office working with the website provider contacts the association office and request from the MLS Data Manager either an IDX agreement or a RETS agreement.
3. Once you get the agreement in your email, fill out the proper section titled “Licensee”
4. Email to your website provider and have them fill out the proper section titled “Participant”
5. They will email the completed form back to the MLS Data manager.
6. The Association Executive will review the agreement and sign if there are no questions or concerns.
7. The MLS Data Manager will contact our MLS provider for a new login and password.
8. The MLS Data Manager will email the website provider with the new login and password information.

### Other helpful information:

IDX stands for International Data Exchange

RETS stands for Real Estate Transaction Standard

If your provider does not know what IDX or RETS is, you should really consider getting a new website provider. There are too many low cost, good looking, real estate website providers out there to reinvent the wheel

The whole process above could take up to a week to complete. This is not something that can be handled in one day.

Do not have the website provider contact the association office for an agreement or send us one of theirs. We can only issue agreements to members and we don't sign other agreements.
